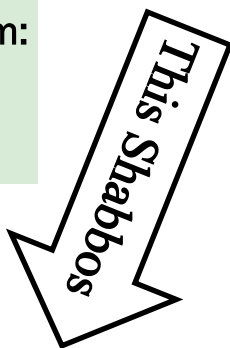

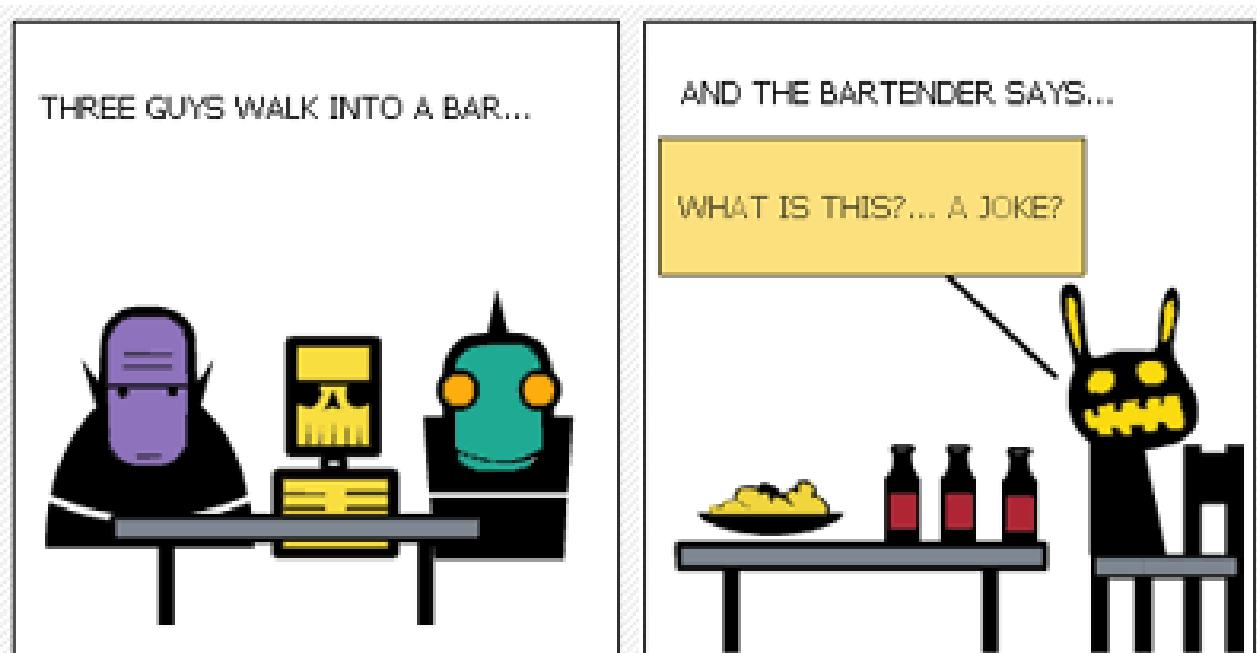

Story of the week

Every year, at the beginning of chodesh Nissan, the Rebbe would send matzos through Reb Zelig Slonim, to various rabbonim in Eretz Yisroel. The famous tzaddik



of Yerushalaim, Reb Aryeh Levin, was one of them. Before Pesach of 5729, Reb Zelig received the matzos for distribution, but Reb Aryeh's name was not on the list. When he mentioned this to the Rebbe, the Rebbe did not respond.

On the ninth of Nissan that year, the tzaddik Reb Aryeh was niftar. Reb Zusha Wilomovsky was one of the special few who would enter the Gan Eden Hatachton, to pick a lulav and esrog from the Rebbe's collection. As the selection would draw to a close, all those present would file by the Rebbe, and receive his bracha.

On Erev Sukkos 5747, Reb Zusha passed by the Rebbe, but the Rebbe did not. (Bentch him and moved on to the next person (as is recorded on video tape.) That year, on Chol Ha-moed Sukkos, Reb Zusha was niftar!
