What sentence can guarantee you getting the gold coin?

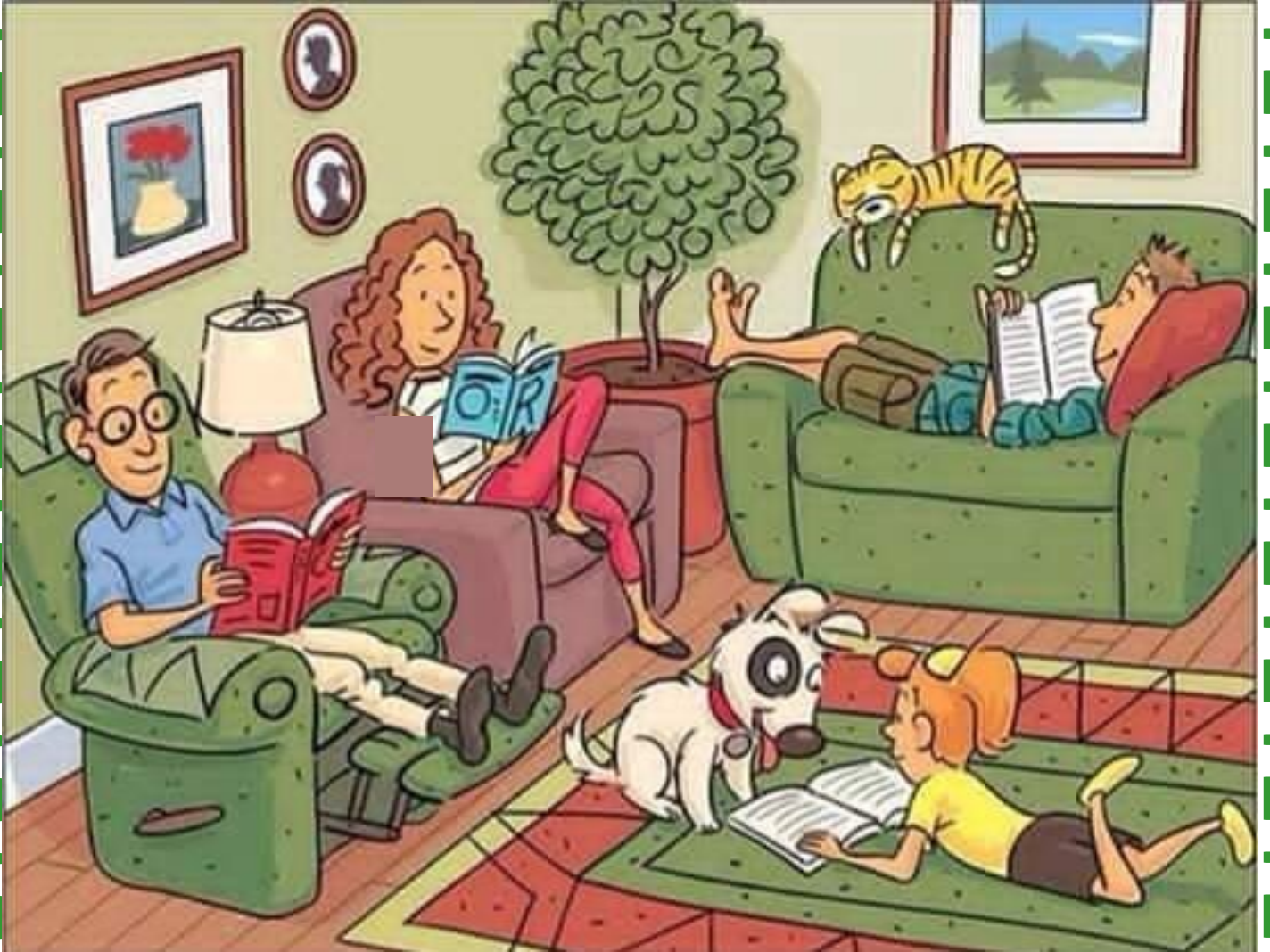

Answer: The doctor is his mother!!!

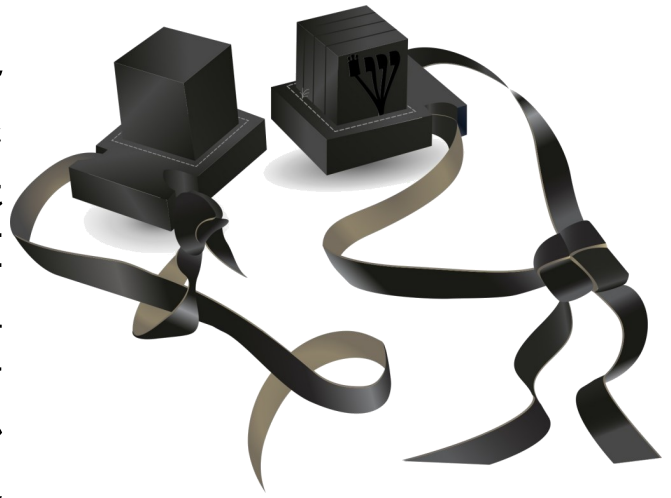

Story of the week

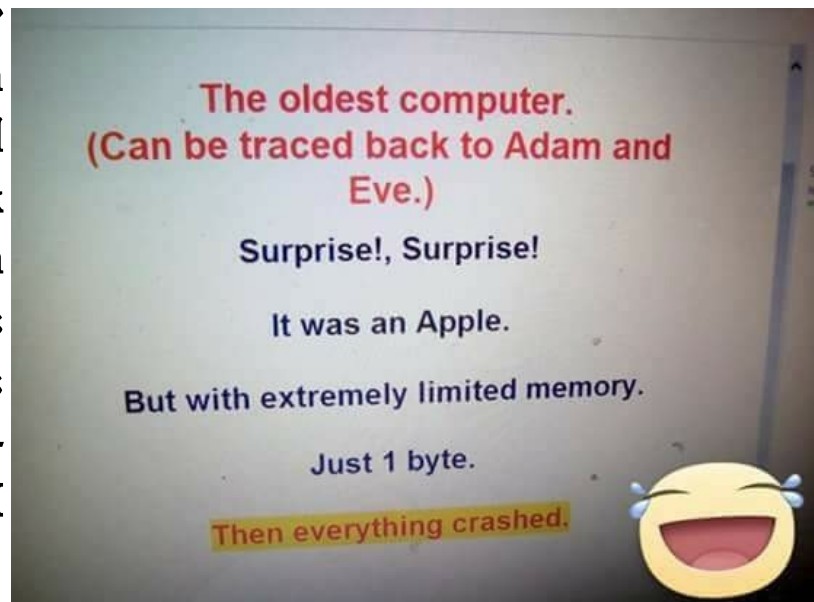
